"[A]ll fees and expenses need to be re-evaluated in light of our holding that the Receivership should not have been created. That conclusion neither authorizes nor prevents further necessary disbursements. The import of our order of November 9, 2012, has not changed, which said this: "Disbursement of any other assets of the Receivership should be as limited as possible ..."

"[T]he only expenditures should be those appropriate for the Receiver to make until relinquishment of control of assets. It is for the district court to make the initial determination of whether approval of additional fees and expenses is appropriate at this time in light of the re-evaluation of all fees and expenses of the Receivership."
